

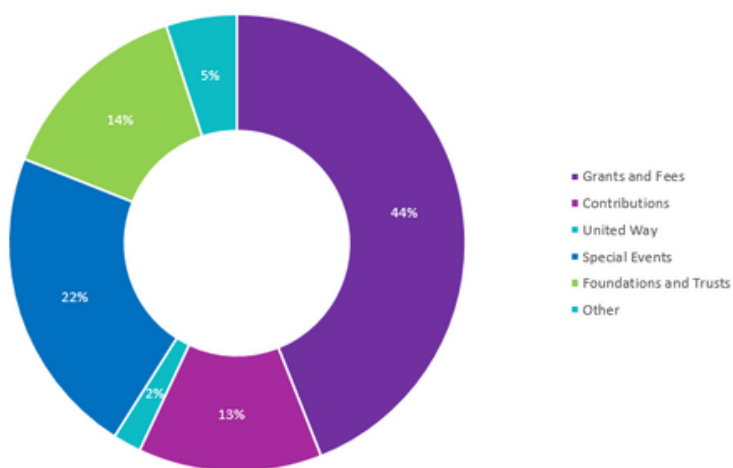

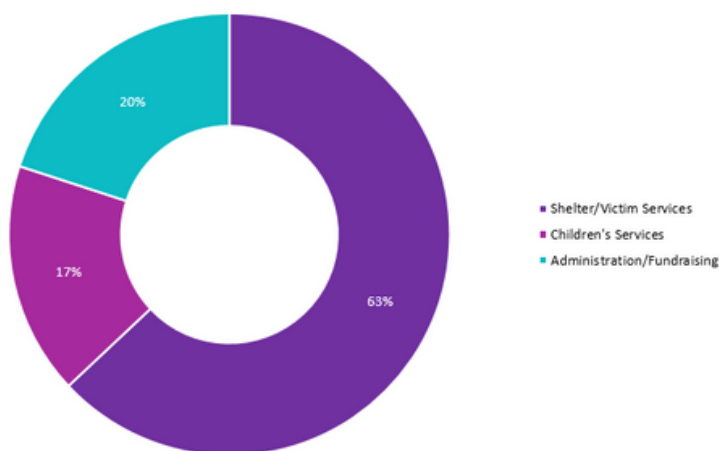


### FINANCIALS

2018 was a year of growth and recognition for Harmony House!

- Talia Apartments opened providing safe, permanent housing for survivors.
- The Family Justice Center opened enabling us to help survivors through a coordinated response in a single location.
- Awarded Best Non-Profit (medium size) by Drury Center for Nonprofit Leadership.
- Awarded Best Awareness Initiative for iCare by Drury Center for Nonprofit Leadership.
- Added a children's therapist and expanded services to children to help our youngest residents.
- Received the O'Reilly Jumpstart grant to help fund Prevention Education in our community.
